ICS believes that the basic need for secure and safe accommodation is fundamental to the personal and educational development of care leavers.

Central to our philosophy is the belief that adolescence can be a difficult period in the journey to adulthood, and that the transition from care to independence compounds these difficulties. Within this, we believe that it is essential that our service addresses the educational, social, and personal needs of the service users.

We intend to deliver our mission through providing:

Supportive semi-independent accommodation for care leavers aged 16-24 and assistance with finding follow-on accommodation when required.

ICS also offers short-term emergency accommodation that makes available accommodation for those young people who need a place to reside whilst overcoming difficulties that they may face.

ICS will provide for a comprehensive needs assessment that reflects the stepping stone to positive adulthood.

A stimulating environment with structured packages that include education, social and personal life skills training.

A warm, welcoming atmosphere that encourages growth, settlement and personal development.
